It usually involves the injection of a small amount of contrast medium into the salivary ducts of a single gland, followed by routine X-ray projections. Category: Radiology How is the Test Performed? The test is performed in a hospital radiology department or in the health care provider's office by an X-ray technician. You may be given a sedative before the procedure. You will be asked to lie on your back on the X-ray table. An X-ray is taken before the contrast material is injected to ensure that no stones are present to stop the contrast material from entering the ducts. A catheter will be inserted through your mouth and into the duct of the salivary gland. A contrast medium is then injected into the duct so that the duct will show up on the X-ray. X-rays will be taken from a number of positions. You may be given lemon juice by mouth to help stimulate the production of saliva.
