## Medical Devices Index

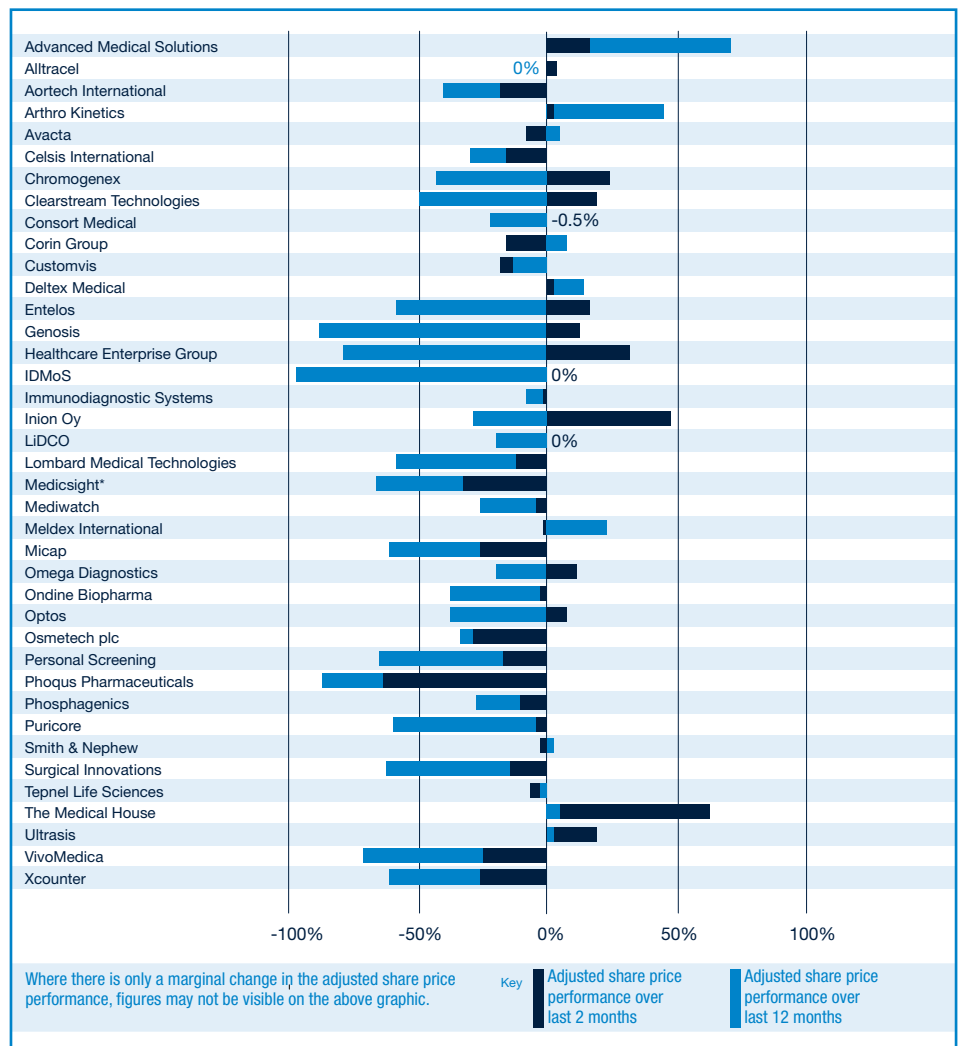
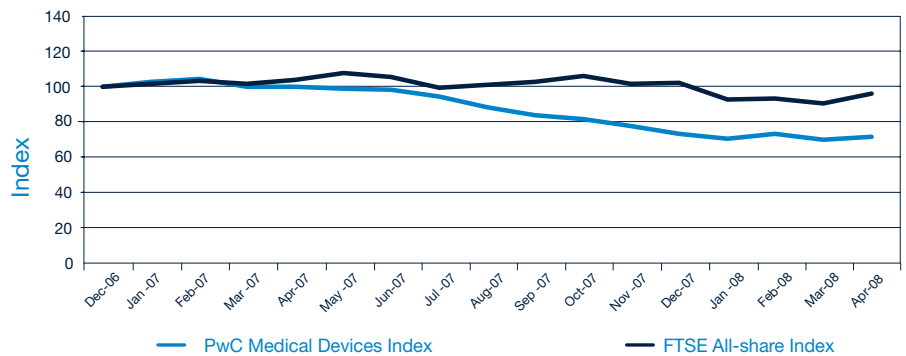
Newly listed companies are assigned the Index at the end of the month in which the company's shares were listed. The Index has decreased during the last two months and is approximately 71% of its value at 31 December 2006.

## RaceCard

The RaceCard analyses the share price performance of 39 UK listed medical devices companies relative to their share price two and twelve months previously.

\* denotes companies who have been listed for less than 12 months and therefore have no adjusted share price performance for this period.
